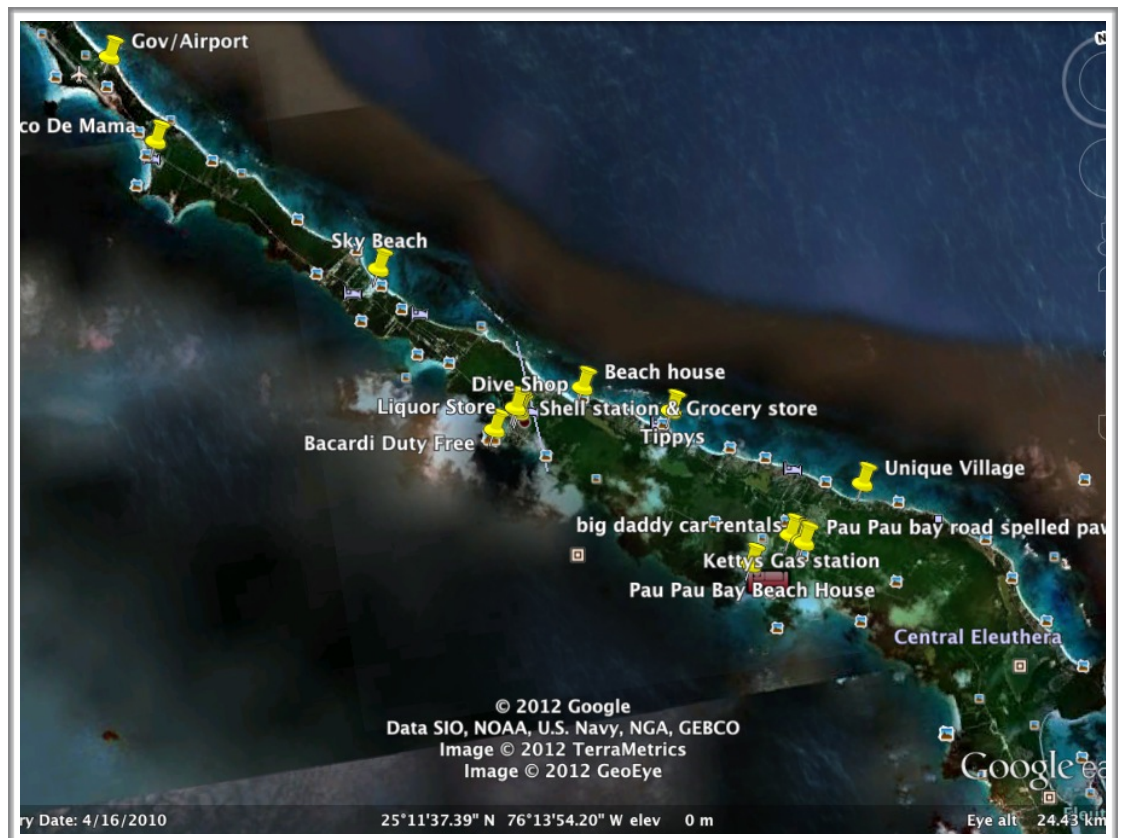


South Palmetto Point Eleuthera

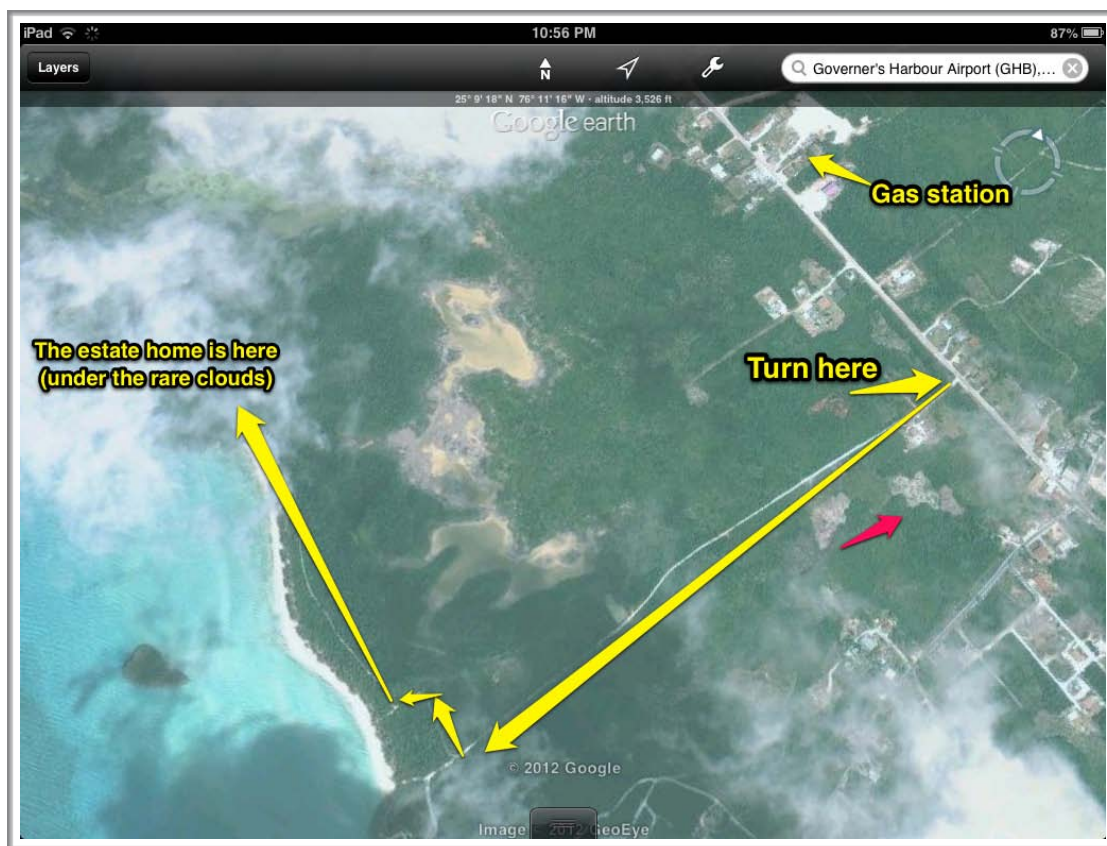
Directions

The property is located approximately 20 minutes south of Governors Harbour Airport.

Take Queens Highway southeast through the town of Governors Harbour, about 10



minutes. Governors has two supermarkets as well a few liquor stores and quaint shops. It is one of the largest villages on the island.



Continue south another 10 minutes and look for Pau Paw Road on the right side. Be sure to look for the road once you have passed Ketty's gas station - also known as Paradise Service Plaza.

Continue down the road for about five minutes -about two miles. Be sure to drive slow throughout as it can change with the weather. The estate is at the end of the road.
